Over the past year the District Council has delivered on several initiatives to assist business in Newark and Sherwood. We have administered more than £31 million worth of grant support to business throughout the pandemic. We have also provided the High Street Diversification Fund to help businesses adapt to COVID-19 restrictions.

More recently, we were successfully granted £25 million from the Government's Towns Fund that will support nine catalyst projects for the regeneration of the town, creating new educational pathways and attracting new industries.

Finally, we have begun to implement a Business Resilience Programme for the district so we can support sectors of businesses to 'bounce back' and grow from COVID-19 together.

With your help, we can distil a vast pool of business experience into this publication, for the benefit of all.


